






Year 6 Learning

Summer Term 1

 <p>English</p>	<p>In English, we will be completing the transition units for High School. They will be reading the story <i>Kensuke's Kingdom</i> by Michael Morpurgo, and completing activities based on this text. We are reading the text as a class and discussing each chapter. We are analysing the characters, the plot and the themes of the story.</p>
 <p>Maths</p>	<p>In maths, we will be completing the transition units for High School and investigating Spirals. Children will learn about the historical links to Spirals and the mathematical patterns involved. They will be drawing a range of different spirals with different mathematical patterns.</p>
 <p>Science</p>	<p>Within science this term we will be looking at Animals including Humans. We will be learning about the functions of our organs, including the digestive system and the circulatory system. We will be thinking about healthy choices we can make and how these choices affect our bodies. We will be learning how exercise can affect our bodies and the sorts of exercise that can be beneficial for our health. To continue to improve our scientific enquiry we will research, investigate and explore a variety of theories and ideas on health and the human body.</p>
 <p>Topic</p>	<p>In topic children will be doing a mini topic about Rivers. They will be investigating the journey of a river, the main parts of a river and rivers around the world. They will be extending their ICT skills, researching rivers and producing information using a range of programmes. Children will be enhancing their art and DT skills through the theme of rivers.</p> <p>We will be to learning about the Ancient Egyptians. We will be learning about the important events and locating where Egypt is in the world. We will be learning about farming in Ancient Egypt. We will learn about the Ancient Egyptian pyramids and their importance and use in Egyptian times. We will be learning about hieroglyphics, Egyptian wall paintings.</p>
