After School Football Coaching

This year we are subsidising the coaching for y3-4 (Autumn/Spring/Summer) for a 10 week block to charge £10 instead of the full cost £25. This has led to a far greater uptake of children participating, of all abilities.

The impact of providing good quality coaching for the younger children has borne fruit with our senior team coming second in the Morecambe High School league in Autumn 2015, reaching the final of the Kids Community Cup at the Globe Arena in January 2016 and winning the William Smith Festival trophy for the first time in 11 years.

Curriculum Time Tag Rugby

Coaches from Morecambe FC Community Sports were hired for 6 weeks to do curriculum time Tag Rugby with both y4 classes, to introduce a sport which very few of our children have previously had access to.

The impact is being seen in a greater number of children getting involved in coaching at local clubs including Trimpell and Vale of Lune.

Gymstars

Sessions for both year one classes have been booked with Morecambe FC Community Sports to take part in the Gymstars Fitness programme in the summer term. This allows young children to have access to modified fitness equipment like static bikes and rowing machines in a fun way and learn how important it is to have a healthy lifestyle.

The impact has been seen in a better attitude towards health and activity at the younger end of the school.

WHEELCHAIR BASKETBALL

For the first time this year, we are hiring Mr Gash and his team of coaches from Lancaster Bulldogs Wheelchair Basketball Club to run a few full day sessions to introduce the sport of wheelchair basketball to youngsters.

The impact we hope to achieve will be seen in an increased awareness of Inclusive Sports and to show children that it is possible to play para sport whilst being able bodied.

LANCASHIRE COUNTY CRICKET BOARD

Chance To Shine (CTS)

As a school we signed up for the Chance To Shine ECB (English Cricket Board) programme which allows children to access cricket coaching and participate in inter school tournaments. Every child in y5/6 will take part in a six week block of coaching delivered by Mr Pemberton (the cricket development officer from Lancashire Cricket Club) and we have been invited to participate in 4 consecutive weeks of Indoor Cricket Tournaments (boys and girls) free of charge against other CTS schools in the area. Outdoor cricket tournaments will be organised for y6 boys' and y6 girls with a new mixed y5 tournament allowing the younger children to participate in competition. Through the CTS scheme we can again access for free in the summer term.

The impact is shown in greater participation in the sport as it allows a larger number of children (especially in y5) to represent school. Youngsters will also be guided towards local clubs at Morecambe CC, Westgate CC, Torrisholme CC and Trimpell CC.

OUR LADY'S CATHOLIC COLLEGE (School Sports Network SSN)

Network Option 2

We signed up to join the School Sports Network along with many other schools in the area. This has allowed us to access free CPD (this year this included KS2 Gymnastics and Football Coaching) with courses run throughout the year and a conference with practical workshops on delivering high quality PE and Sport. It has also allowed us free entry into National School Games Competitions for a variety of sports including Tag Rugby, Hi 5 Netball, Football, Tennis Red, Boccia, Orienteering and Sportshall Athletics. Local Level 2 Qualifiers are held throughout the year which potentially can lead to a Level 3 Lancashire Championship. We send teams in four different sports (last year it was Orienteering (y5/6), Tri Golf(y3/4/5/6), Wheelchair Basketball(y5) and QuadKids Athletics(y4)) to the SSN School Gamesn which take

place at Salt Ayre in May. This season we are also playing in the local SSN football league against schools from further afield such as Caton and Moorside, Lancaster.

We are also able to send 6 children to a Young Leaders' Conference where they are able to access training for working with younger children.

Last year our Mini Tennis Red (y4) squad and our Sportshall Athletics (y4/5/6) squad won their District Level 2 competitions and went to Blackpool and Accrington respectively to compete in the Level 3 County Championships.

The impact of being part of the SSN is mainly seen in the increased opportunities for children to represent school in a range of competitive and non-competitive events.

MORECAMBE COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL

Outdoor Education Partnership

Along with another 12 primary schools, we have entered into a partnership with MCHS to employ an Outdoor Education teacher to help deliver Outdoor Education throughout KS2 to enable us to deliver the new statutory strand of the KS2 PE Curriculum.

Our partnership entitles us to 8 teacher days from MCHS, and this is being used to deliver a full day of orienteering during curriculum time for all children in y3 (2 days). In addition all the y4 had the chance to do Ghyll Scrambling in small groups of 10 as a full day of Outdoor Adventure in the Lake District (6 days).

As part of the OEP with Morecambe Community High, we are also invited to free competitions which take place at Morecambe High. These include the Outdoor Football league played on the 3G surface, a y4 Dodgeball competition and various other events like Orienteering and y3/4 Mixed Football.

The impact of the OEP is seen in a better delivery of the new KS2 Outdoor Ed Curriculum, with access to specialist teaching and a range of resources we can use in school.

The other main impact lies in the increased opportunities for children to represent school in a range of competitions at Morecambe High.

PE TA/ LUNCHTIME SUPPORT

This year we have employed Miss Hilton to lead sporting activity at lunchtimes and to support staff in the delivery of the Outdoor Games Curriculum. She has been assisting and leading after school clubs including Netball throughout KS2 which has led to us being able to enter a Hi5 Netball Competition for the first time in many years.

The main impact has been increased activity levels at lunchtime and the opportunities for children to be taught in smaller groups during Curriculum time.

Sustainability

As well as increasing participation in sport and PE and increased health benefits for the children staff have had their confidence in teaching PE and games increased through having the opportunity to work alongside expert sport coaches.

Future

In 2016/17 we intend to continue to provide high quality coaching for the children in a variety of sports. Following the departure of our Sports TA we will reappoint in order to continue to support our staff and children in the delivery of high quality PE / sport activity. With the addition of a new hall as part of the new build we are also able to offer more lunchtime sport clubs including a new table tennis club.
