Year 1	Term - Spring 2015	Pirates
<p><u>Science</u> Materials - to look at the properties of different materials. Testing different materials to see which would make the best sail on a pirate ship. Choosing appropriate materials to make a 3D model of a pirate ship.</p>	<p><u>History</u> Look at the history of pirates; the life of a pirate, pirate ships, life at different times (comparing life on a pirate ship and a ship now), pirates traditional dress, famous pirates.</p>	
<p><u>Art & Design</u> Painting - pirates, ships. Drawing - practising basic observational drawing skills Media - Chalk Texture - Pastels Colour - Colour mixing, shading - light and dark Look at the work of Lowry - use pastels and paints to attempt to replicate. Paint effect with salt.</p>	<p><u>Music</u> Pirate songs - <i>Portside pirates, rhymes (A Sailor went to sea, sea, sea etc).</i></p>	
<p><u>Computing</u> Technology - 2 simple programs - drawing - stories Textease Focus on using basic functions: save, open, editing, printing etc Teaching how to log on individually - RM Maths/ Lexia etc</p>	<p><u>Physical Education</u> Gym (using apparatus) - Children will practise different roll techniques. They will develop their balancing and jumping skills to perform a sequence of movements on different gym apparatus. Dance - Children will learn skills needed to perform a pirate dance as a whole class.</p>	
<p><u>Design & Technology</u> Mechanisms - Look at and explore different moving pictures. Designing own pirate pictures with a moving part of their choice. Modelling pirate ships - children to construct their own mast/ anchor/ sails/ rigging etc.</p>	<p><u>Values Education</u> Love Caring Freedom</p>
