

<b>Year Group: 3</b>	<b>Term :Spring</b>	<b>Theme: Bookmakers</b>
<p><b>Science:</b>  <u>Magnets and Forces</u>  <u>Light and Astronomy</u>  (science not linked to topic work this term)</p>	<p><b>History:</b>  A study of how the local area has developed from a small village to become part of a large town. Focus on community buildings and how they have changed over time. Considerations of local issues that may change the area further.</p>	
<p><b>Art and Design:</b>  Focus on observational drawings, using charcoal, of buildings in Morecambe.  All children will study the illustrations by Quentin Blake used in the Roald Dahl books and will sketch characters from the books. Water colour paints used for this activity.  Mixing paint skills will be used to paint characters from Roald's books.</p>	<p><b>Languages:</b>  Learning basic nouns for the classroom, colours and how to say your age. Learning how to give basic instructions in the classroom.</p>	
<p><b>Computing:</b>  Focus this term on programming using coding, using iPads and desk top classroom computers.  Class computers used to complement the curriculum.</p>	<p><b>Music:</b>  The focus will be on understanding and playing pentatonic scales on glockenspiels. (no link to the Bookmakers topic)</p>	
<p><b>Design and technology:</b>  Designing, making and evaluating book covers in for anthology linked to topic work.  Designing and making 'binka' bookmarks</p>	<p><b>Physical Education:</b>  Outdoor games will focus on hockey skills and playing short games. Indoor PE will focus on balance and movement on large apparatus.  All children will start swimming lessons after the February half term.</p>	
<p><b>Geography:</b>  Map work linked to world and European maps. Understanding scale and plotting Morecambe Library on local map. Images linked to the locality.</p>
