## Purpose

The purpose of the PPG is to reduce the gap in attainment for those eligible children.

**Allocation amount** £187,420 (15/16 £198,460)

## Barriers to Learning

Lack of resources for these children in the wider community.

Speech and Language skills. Access to a wider vocabulary.

Home reading books. Access to high quality resources

Early experiences not developed at home.

Accessibility to enriching environments such as Museums, art galleries, theatres which impact on key skills development.

Engagement with wider educational experiences.

Families requiring support with behaviour, housing and a high level of mental health issues and child protection. This is being increased with closure of Children's Centre.

## How we will Spend

As in 2015/16 we intend to continue to support the children in a variety of ways.

- Additional TA support to deliver personalised intervention programmes;
- Quality First Teaching. Employing an additional early years/Key Stage 1 practitioner (0.6FTE);
- Additional welfare staff to ensure the most vulnerable pupils supported through lunch hour;
- Continue to employ a Learning Mentor;
- Employing a Pupil Support worker;
- Employing a Family Support Worker to support vulnerable children and families;
- Additional TA support before and after school to increase punctuality and attendance;
- Sports TA employed to encourage participation and attendance (this is joint funded with Sports grant);
- Provision of extra-curricular activities for children both in an out of school – linking to Children's University;
- Development of Pastoral team and provision of nurture groups and a breakfast club;
- Support for children through a bought in Specialist Teacher;
- Support for children and families through a bought in Educational Psychologist;
- Enabling pupils to participate in school residential and educational trips through cost subsidy;
- Reward and Incentive schemes.
- Timely and prompt support by SENCo to develop parent partnership and support families who may need to access additional services.

## How we will measure

The impact of these will be measured in the form of case studies from the SENCo, FSW, PSW and Learning Mentor. Termly reports to Governors to be introduced from Spring Term 2017. The children will be monitored and tracked as a specific group throughout the year.

Clear expected targets in terms of progress and attainment for PPG pupils. 70% are expected to reach ARE in Reading/writing/Maths at Y6. Pupils to make accelerated progress from low starting points and achieve as well as their peers. Absence to be reduced to below 4%.
